COMMUNITY CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE ANNUAL REPORT 2014



Committee Establishment

In May 2014, Umwelt (Australia) Pty Ltd approached Queanbeyan City Council on behalf of Holcim Australia Pty Ltd to establish a Community Consultative Committee for Cooma Road Quarry.

Cooma Road Quarry Community Consultative Committee was quickly appointed and referred to the NSW Department of Planning and Environment for approval on 27 May 2014. At this stage Queanbeyan City Council had not yet formally appointed an Independent Chair.

At Queanbeyan City Council meeting of 11 June 2014, Councillor Sue Whelan OAM was elected to the position of Independent Chair.

Holcim continue to operate a Community contact line. There have been no complaints reported to the committee.

Holcim have partnered in installing a hand painted large rock at the site entrance which acts as a flag stand. It celebrates the relationship between the Ngambri people and Holcim. This is considered a symbolic and positive dedication to the community.

The committee was pleased to see the newly constructed 'viewing platform' which can be used for tour groups.
