5	<b>Quarry Intersection</b> – Concerns over the intersection at Cooma Road. Council engineers have investigated with the Police. They will deploy traffic counters for data and strategic enforcement. Discussion whether the hold line at the stop sign should be increased out. The “noise barrier” makes it difficult to see on coming traffic. Discussions over whether the noise barrier is actually effective. Further discussions with Council Engineers required.	PH	
6	<b>Ellerton Drive Extension</b> – Tenders are closing for the road works. The Quarry has been approached by some tendering companies for this committee to be used for community engagement for the Ellerton Drive Extension Project.  It was resolved that this committee is not appropriate for this forum.	PH	

7	<p><b>Cooma Road Quarry Environmental Improvements</b></p> <p>The following improvements are in progress:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A new weigh bridge is to be installed.</li> <li>• Erosion and sediment controls around the pit</li> <li>• Plantings from National Tree Day have taken off and additional planting with Greening Australia on southern side</li> <li>• Concrete wastes are being returned</li> </ul> <p>Discussion on flows through Barracks Flat Creek. Noted that there seems to be a spring running all the time. Results of water quality testing and blast monitoring are available on the Holcim website. <i>See attachment for monitoring summary.</i></p>	PH	
8	<p><b>Parking of trucks on Edwin Land Parkway verge at the Jerrabomberra Shopping Centre</b></p> <p>Main issues are the dust affecting nearby residents from trucks parking and pedestrian movement on the southern side.</p> <p>Issue to be referred to Council engineers. Committee can see three possible outcomes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Police the parking on the southern side</li> <li>• Restrict parking</li> <li>• Create a formal truck pull in parking bay.</li> </ul> <p>Peter advised Holcim could contribute to construction of option 3.</p> <p><b>ACTION: NA to refer matter to Council engineers</b></p>	MZ	
9	<p><b>General Business</b></p> <p><b>Bio-connectivity</b> – We have had some great partnerships between Landcare, Holcim, Molonglo Catchment Group and Council. Examples include offset planting and Environa small bird plantings. The steering committee on these projects should be reactivated for long term beneficial outcomes.</p> <p>Council still has some budget for signage which is currently in progress. The draft graphics could be presented to the group.</p> <p><b>ACTION: NA to coordinate a meeting of stakeholders. Agenda and minutes to be sent to members of this committee.</b></p> <p>Landcare active on Mt Jerrabomberra and Stringybark . Council currently has a consultant working on a new Fire Plan for Mt Jerrabomberra. Same consultant who prepared Stringybark Fire Plan. Quarry concerned that long grass in Offset land.</p> <p><b>ACTION: NA to send out Stringybark Fire Plan and Draft to Mt Jerrabomberra Fire Plan when it is available.</b></p> <p><b>National Tree Day</b> – NTD is Sunday 30 July. Carolyn Larcombe is organising planting of 2000 trees on Wandiyali (neighbouring quarry) with assistance of a Green Army team.</p> <p><b>Membership</b> – It is suggested that we expand membership on committee.</p> <p><b>ACTION: NA to send out a letter to Carolyn Larcombe and Googong Residents Association.
