<p>Member feedback & Open forum</p>	<p>Update on Urban Rivers and Catchment Program:</p> <p>The project is into its second year. The report from the Ormeau Bottle tree samples collected is in the final stage, with the results to be finalised roughly at the end of June.</p> <p>Additional funding has been obtained to conduct more sampling which will be focused on collecting samples from mature Ormeau Bottle trees, and a bird survey to be conducted later in the project.</p> <p>Ormeau Progress Association (Peachey Community Garden) are holding an Open Day on Saturday 15 August to celebrate the completion of the new nature playground.</p> <p>Update on questions from previous meeting:</p> <p>Stewart asked if Holcim have funding to cover pool maintenance for nearby residents? Answer: There is no current funding for residential pool maintenance.</p> <p>Heather suggested Holcim get in touch with local high schools to promote awareness and educate them about the Ormeau Bottle Tree. Answer: Holcim is open to engage with a third party to promote awareness and educate local schools.</p>
