Subject: Update: Production and Transport Surcharge

Dear Valued Customer,

Consistent with our commitment to regularly review our operational inputs, we have completed our fortnightly assessment for the Production and Transport Surcharge.

We note that the National Terminal Gate Price (**NTGP**) for diesel has recently experienced an upward trend, surpassing \$2/L on Friday 17th July, placing pressure on logistics and other input costs. However, recognising the challenges the current economic climate creates for your business, Holcim will continue to absorb these increased costs to provide price stability for your active projects.

The Production and Transport Surcharge will remain at **\$0/m³** for the upcoming fortnightly period. Should the NTGP remain high during the next two weeks, Holcim will likely reintroduce the Production and Transportation Surcharge in the next fortnightly update.
