Subject: Update: Production and Transport Surcharge

Dear Valued Customer,

Consistent with our commitment to regularly review our operational inputs, we have completed our fortnightly assessment for the Production and Transport Surcharge.

We note that the National Terminal Gate Price (**NTGP**) for diesel has continued its upward trend, placing pressure on logistics and other input costs. While Holcim has absorbed these cost increases over recent weeks to help provide price stability for your active projects, this sustained upward trend means we must now reinstate the Production and Transportation Surcharge. It should be noted that the last remaining fuel excise relief will be turned off 2nd August, which will add even more pressure on costs.

Effective for the upcoming fortnightly period, the Production and Transport Surcharge will be reinstated at **\$7.34 m³**. We will continue to monitor market conditions closely during our regular fortnightly review cycle.
