Confirmation of the minutes of the previous meeting: A motion was asked that they were accepted as true and accurate from the previous meeting. Grahame McWilliam confirmed the previous minutes. Seconded by Julia Franzos .

Business arising from the previous minutes – response to issues raised or provision of additional information requested:

- Chris Cherry's supposed resignation and David Norris taking over her position.
- 3 wild dogs trapped and shot (6months) all were dingo cross.
- Adam liaising with the government about the last audit that has been postponed to a later date due to a lack of turnover.
- Discussions regarding the salt water readings, which are reported monthly. The test are trying to be conducted at low tide to ensure consistent results.
- The environmental assessments and reports –need to be confirmed with Adam.
Department of Planning has confirmed testing need only be done on 1 3 5 6 & 7 bore holes.
- Recent algae testing has shown a 0 result for blue green algae.

Company Reports and overview of activities – progress at the mine (operational issues):

- Since the election, 25-30% increase in sales mainly for concrete render and loam.

- Contract with SEE CIVIL MIRAMAR, ongoing.
- Additionally some quotes for 2014 have been made to some Kingscliff developers.
- Confirmed 10,000ton(approximately) Lend Lease Contract.

Steve confirmed that this rehabilitation has already commenced and that there are photos of this in the last environmental report. And that 1200 trees will be added to the rehabilitation when weather conditions are suitable, however a significant about of natural rehabilitation has already taken place.
