1. Progress at the mine

Production has continued within the approved extraction limits, with no operational issues to report.

The newly acquired dredge is operating effectively. A mobile screen has also been sourced to screen a loam product for bricklayers. Since the previous meeting agenda was circulated we have seen sales drop off due to the border closures between NSW and QLD; however this is expected to alleviate when border restrictions ease.

Road repairs have been completed on the entrance haul road to site.

Dan Dwyer (production supervisor) has gone on extended leave for a period of 12 months. A replaced site supervisor is in process of being filled.

An independent environmental audit was conducted by a third party contractor approved by the EPA, with no significant issues raised.
